Unpaved Roadway Dust Control and Grading Plan

Purpose

To establish a dust control and grading plan for unpaved Town roads.

Specifications

The Town of Firestone Public Works Department is responsible for unpaved road maintenance. Our services for the maintenance of unpaved roads includes grading, shaping, placing new dirt or gravel, and stabilization (dust control).

The Town of Firestone maintains several miles of dirt/gravel roads. Public Works shall conduct weekly visual inspections of all unpaved roads to determine if grading and/or dust control is required. Unpaved road inspections and maintenance shall be logged and kept on record.

1. Road grading is scheduled to be completed at the beginning of each week.
**Road condition, time allowance and weather permitting.*
2. Dust control products are applied when the daily traffic count exceeds 200 vehicles per day to inhibit fugitive dust. This is in accordance with the State Dept. of Health, regulation 1 section III.D.2.a.
 - a. When a roadway meets the criteria for dust control, the Town may, when practical and within budgetary constraints, reduce speed limit and/or spray dust control agents. The dust control agents Mag-chloride, Roadsaver, Durablend or other products are environmentally safe soil stabilization materials.

Overview

The Town of Firestone shall provide unpaved road maintenance in accordance with all state and local regulations and laws. (*State Dept. of Health, regulation 1 section III.D.2.a.; Firestone Municipal Code 8.08*)
