## **FIRESTONE ACADEMIC PERFORMANCE Scholarship Criteria**

**The Town of Firestone wishes to present the Youth in Government Academic Performance Scholarship Award.**

**A \$1,000.00 Academic Performance Scholarship will be awarded. The following is the criteria that must be met in order to apply for an Academic Performance Scholarship. This Academic Performance Scholarship is intended for use at a four-year college or university.**

**Currently a senior in High School, graduating in May 2010.**

**The student must be a resident of the Town of Firestone.**

**The Scholarship application with official school transcript (official raised seal) and SAT and ACT testing results must be submitted to Firestone Town Hall by April 2, 2010, included with the application packet.**

**Student must have a minimum overall 3.5 Grade Point Average.**

**Student must submit a 1000-word essay regarding their chosen profession.**

**Student has demonstrated community involvement (excluding school-related service).**

**Student should provide a letter of recommendation from the place of community service. A letter of recommendation's not required if service is through the Town of Firestone.**

**Student will need a letter of recommendation from a teacher or school advisor.**

**Scholarship must be used for the fall semester and will be paid directly to the institution student will be attending.**



## **SAFEBUILT ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE Scholarship Criteria**

**The Town of Firestone wishes to present the Safebuilt Academic Scholarship Award.**

**A \$1,000.00 Safebuilt Academic Scholarship will be awarded. The following is the criteria that must be met in order to apply for a Safebuilt Academic Scholarship. This Scholarship is intended for use at a four-year college or university.**

**Currently a senior in High School, graduating in May 2010.**

**The student must be a resident of the Town of Firestone.**

**The Scholarship application with official school transcript (official raised seal) and SAT or ACT testing results (copy) must be submitted to Firestone Town Hall by April 2, 2010.**

**Student must have a minimum overall 3.25 Grade Point Average.**

**Student must submit a 500-word essay regarding their chosen profession.**

**Student has demonstrated community involvement (excluding school-related service).**

**Student should provide a letter of recommendation from the place of community service. A letter of recommendation is not required if service is through the Town of Firestone.**

**Student will need a letter of recommendation from a teacher or school advisor.**

**Scholarship must be used for the fall semester and will be paid directly to the institution the student will be attending.**



## **FIRESTONE CAREER ADVANCEMENT Scholarship Criteria**

**The Town of Firestone wishes to present the Youth in Government Career Advancement Scholarship award.**

**A \$1,000.00 scholarship will be awarded for Career Advancement. This scholarship is intended for use at a junior college, technical/trade School or business college.**

**Currently a senior in High School, graduating in May 2010.**

**The student must be a resident of the Town of Firestone.**

**The completed Scholarship application, transcript (raised school seal), and SAT and ACT test results (copies) must be submitted to Firestone Town Hall by April 2, 2010.**

**Student must earn three hours of Community Service, in addition to the graduation requirement, and present a letter of recommendation from the place of community service. A letter of recommendation is not required if community service is through the Town of Firestone.**

**A letter of recommendation from a teacher or school advisor.**

**Student must have a 2.5 Grade Point Average. Please provide an official school transcript (raised seal).**

**Student must submit a 500-word essay regarding their chosen profession.**

**Scholarship must be used for the fall semester and will be paid directly to the institution the student is attending.**



## **FIRESTONE PUBLIC SAFETY CAREER Scholarship Criteria**

**A \$1,000.00 Criminal Justice Scholarship will be awarded. This scholarship is intended for a student desiring an education in the field of Public Safety, including Law Enforcement, Fire Fighter, or Park Ranger. The following is the criteria for the award.**

**Currently a senior in High School or in the International Baccalaureate Program through the school system. Graduating in May 2010.**

**The student must be a resident of the Town of Firestone.**

**Student must have an interest in Public Safety as a career goal.**

**A Scholarship application with transcript attached must be turned into the Town of Firestone by April 2, 2010 at 5:00 p.m.**

**Student must have a 3.0 Grade Point Average. With official SAT or ACT test results.**

**Student must submit a 500-word essay on the topic:  
“Why am I interested in public safety as a career?”**

**Student has demonstrated community involvement (excluding school-related service), with letter of recommendation from the place of community service. No letter of recommendation is required if community service is for the Town of Firestone.**

**A letter of recommendation from a teacher or school advisor.**

**Scholarship must be used for the fall semester and will be paid directly to the institution the student is attending.**
