Clean Up day

The Town of Firestone will be hosting its 9th annual residential Clean Up Day on Saturday, May 1st, 2010 from 8am to 4pm. Bring all your unwanted household debris to 7500 WCR 20 (Firestone Public Works Facility). Truckloads containing loose materials and/or debris must be covered. Please *no commercial waste*, residential only. Participants will be asked to separate wood and steel when unloading. Town staff will be available to help those unload that are unable to do so themselves. In addition, Firestone Town Officials will be there throughout the day.

ITEMS ACCEPTED:



Includes: lumber, tree branches, shrubs, furniture, concrete, doors, cabinets, screens/monitors, TV's, stereo equipment, yard equipment, bicycles, tires, chain link fences, steel, etc.

Household Hazardous waste will also be accepted on Clean Up Day. Allowable household hazardous materials include: Flammable Materials, latex and related materials, oil, antifreeze and other car products, toxic material, batteries, aerosol, acids, bases, oxidizers and unknowns. All materials **MUST** be in a clearly marked container and properly packaged so that leakage doesn't occur.
