### **LOW INTEREST LOANS AVAILABLE**

The Weld County Housing Authority has the funds available at this time to help you improve your property through a low-interest loan. Home repairs such as structure, plumbing, heating or electrical wiring are some things being offered. Interest rates will vary from 0-3 percent.

The most attractive feature of the program is that we can set the payment amount to accommodate the ability of the applicant to repay.

Program goals are eliminating health and safety conditions that would endanger homeowners or tenants. Repair examples could include unsafe wiring, lead piping in the water lines, inadequate or dangerous heat systems, roof leaks, weatherization, and unsafe waste systems.

Program funds can also be used to help persons with disabilities with accessibility modifications to their homes.

Applicants must meet income guidelines and other qualifications established by the federal government.
